DECISION

RENEWAL OF THE APPOINTMENT OF THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

The Conference of the States Parties,

Recalling that, according to Article VIII, paragraph 43, of the Chemical Weapons Convention, the Director-General of the Technical Secretariat (hereinafter “the Secretariat”) shall be appointed by the Conference of the States Parties (hereinafter “the Conference”) upon the recommendation of the Executive Council (hereinafter “the Council”) for a term of four years, renewable for one further term, but not thereafter;

Recalling also that at its Fourteenth Session it appointed Mr Ahmet Üzümcü as the Director-General for a term of office beginning on 25 July 2010 and ending on 24 July 2014 (C-14/DEC.6, dated 2 December 2009);

Bearing in mind that Mr Üzümcü’s current term of office will expire prior to its Nineteenth Session; and

Noting the recommendation of the Council at its Seventy-Fourth Session that it renew Mr Üzümcü’s appointment for one further term of four years (EC-74/DEC.3, dated 10 October 2013);

Hereby:

1. **Appoints** Mr Ahmet Üzümcü as the Director-General of the Secretariat of the OPCW for one further term of four years beginning on 25 July 2014 and ending on 24 July 2018; and, accordingly,
2. **Authorises** the Chairperson of the Conference to conclude a contract with the Director-General on the terms and conditions set out in C-SS-1/DEC.4, dated 25 July 2002, as periodically adjusted by the Council in conformity with the provisions of the last operative paragraph of that decision.
